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TOOLS REQUIRED

- Set of metric Allen keys or socket bits to include 8mm A/F size.
 - Torque wrench (up-to 40Nm).
 - Suitable Jack or support mechanism.
 - Block of wood or plastic.

GENERAL TORQUE SETTINGS

M4 BOLT = 8Nm

M5 BOLT = 12Nm

M6 BOLT = 15Nm


M8 BOLT = 20Nm

M10 BOLT = 40Nm

M12 BOLT = 40Nm

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

• It is advisable to support the engine with a jack and block of wood/plastic as shown in picture 1 to prevent any engine movement when the original engine bolts are loosened/removed (do not use excessive lifting forces as damage can occur).

Off side (right side as you sit on the motorcycle)

- Remove the frame tube cover and remove the bolt arrowed in picture 2.
- Remove the bolt arrowed in picture 3.
- Offer the right-hand side adventure bar (**item 5**) into position as shown in **picture 4**.
- Engage one of the longer bolts (**item 4**) through the front mount and into the engine-mount (do not fully tighten at this stage).
- Engage one of the shorter bolts (**item 2**) through the rear mount and into the engine-mount (do not fully tighten at this stage).
- Tighten both bolts ensuring no parts of the adventure bars contact any motorcycle parts.
- Fit the bolt covers (item 3) into the bolt heads.

Near side (left side as you sit on the motorcycle)

- Remove the frame tube cover and remove the bolt arrowed in **picture 5**.
- Remove the bolt arrowed in picture 6.
- Offer the right-hand side adventure bar (**item 1**) into position as shown in the **top picture**.
- Engage one of the longer bolts (**item 4**) through the front mount and into the engine-mount (do not fully tighten at this stage).
- Engage one of the shorter bolts (**item 2**) through the rear mount and into the engine-mount (do not fully tighten at this stage).
- Tighten both bolts ensuring no parts of the adventure bars contact any motorcycle parts.
- Fit the bolt covers (item 3) into the bolt heads.
- Before riding, please recheck tightness of all bolts, and the operation of the motorcycle at full lock in both directions.

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
