

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



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- To fit the R&G tail tidy, lift the seat using the key and release button.
- Remove the two plastic covers on the handrail on the left side of the bike, as arrowed in picture 1, and remove the two bolts underneath. Remove the handrail from the bike.
- Remove the rubber panel adjoining the rear panels to gain access to the bolts underneath, as shown in picture 2.
- Unclip and remove the rubber cover shown in picture 3 and remove the bolt shown in picture 4.
- Remove the bolts shown in pictures 5-10. This will allow you to remove the side panel shown in picture 5, and allow access to the final bolt to remove in order to remove the larger side panel which will reveal the wiring for the OEM tail unit.
- Disconnect the connector shown in picture 11 and cut any cable ties securing the tail unit wiring to the bike.
- While supporting the tail unit Remove the 4 x hex bolts in the underside of the OEM tail unit as shown in picture 12.
- Remove the OEM tail unit from the bike ensuring to pass the wiring through the opening in the LHS of the bike and remove completely.
- Offer the cover plate (**Item 3**) up to the main bracket (**Item 2**) and secure in place using 4 of the M5 countersunk bolts (**Item 4**), M5 washers (**Item 5**) and M5 nyloc nuts (**Item 7**).
- Feed the wire of the new R&G licence plate illuminator (**Item 6**) through the upper central hole in the new licence plate bracket (**Item 1**) and underneath the cover plate (**Item 3**).
- Secure the illuminator using the M3 washers and nuts supplied as shown in picture 13.
- Fit one length of heat-shrink (Item 13) to the wires and heat gently to shrink to fit.
- Fit the light shroud and use a small amount of adhesive to hold it in position; this will help direct the light correctly.
- Neatly route the wiring with the licence plate illuminator wiring using the cable ties and cable clips supplied.
- Take the tail tidy assembly and offer it up underneath the tail whilst feeding the wire up through the small hole where the OEM wiring exited from, attach the CON0014 adaptor (**Item 14**) as shown in picture 14 and plug the CON0014 into the OEM harness.

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- Take the four M6 x 16mm long button head bolts (**Item 8**) and four M6 washers (**Item 9**) and fit through the four mounting holes of the tail tidy before tightening into the threaded bosses on the subframe, as shown in picture 15.
- Check for the correct operation of all lights, if illumination fails on any light, re-connect the bullet connectors the other way around.
- Ensure the wiring is all neatly routed behind the panel using the cable ties (Item 10) and selfadhesive cable clips (Item 11).
- Re-fit the bodywork and the hand-rails in a reverse procedure of how they were removed.
- Re-fit the licence plate (it may require drilling).
- Depending on local laws, attach enclosed reflector (Item 12) in an appropriate location.
- Test the licence plate illuminator and all lights before riding.
- IMPORTANT: IF FITTING A FULL-SIZE LICENCE PLATE AND PLACING IT FAR DOWN ON THE LICENCE PLATE HANGER, THERE IS A SMALL CHANCE OF THE LICENCE PLATE HITTING THE BACK WHEEL UNDER HEAVY LOAD AND OVER LARGE BUMPS IN THE ROAD. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK FOR THIS POSSIBILITY AND TAKE AVOIDING ACTION. FAILURE TO CHECK THIS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.
