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

# **FITTING INSTRUCTIONS**

Before removing engine bolts, ensure the bike is upright and supported by a suitable engine stand or jack placed under the sump of the motorbike to support the partial weight of the engine, this will prevent the engine from moving during fitting. DO NOT REMOVE MORE THAN 1 ENGINE BOLT AT ANY TIME.

- Remove the OEM bolt in position arrowed in **picture B** on page 3.
- Assemble the crash protector kit as shown in the **EXPLODED ASSEMBLY VIEW**.
- Offer this assembly into position as shown in **picture A** on page 1. Finally tighten the crash protector bolts until you feel some compression from inside the protector using 17mm socket and wrench. **PLEASE NOTE THE CRASH PROTECTOR MUST BE POSITIONED AS SHOWN IN THE ASSEMBLY DIAGRAMS WITH BIGGER END TOWARD FRONT OF BIKE.** Turn a little more so that you feel the compression increase slightly. Then apply a quarter turn. Tighten to 40Nm of torque (do not exceed this figure, as damage can occur to the motorcycle and the bolt).
- If not already fitted, fit bubble sticker into recess of crash protector cap (ITEM 6).
- Fit crash protector cap (ITEM 6) into the crash protector (ITEM 1).

#### REPEAT THE ABOVE STEPS FOR BOTH SIDES OF THE MOTORCYLCE.



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
