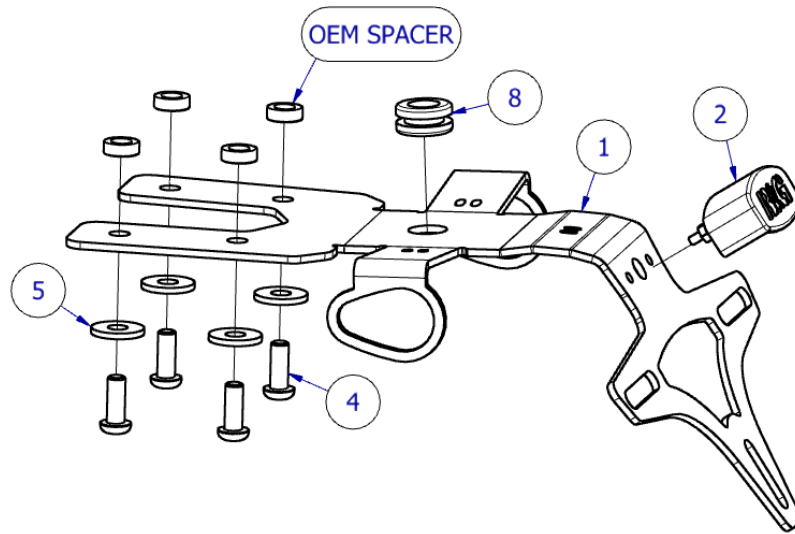

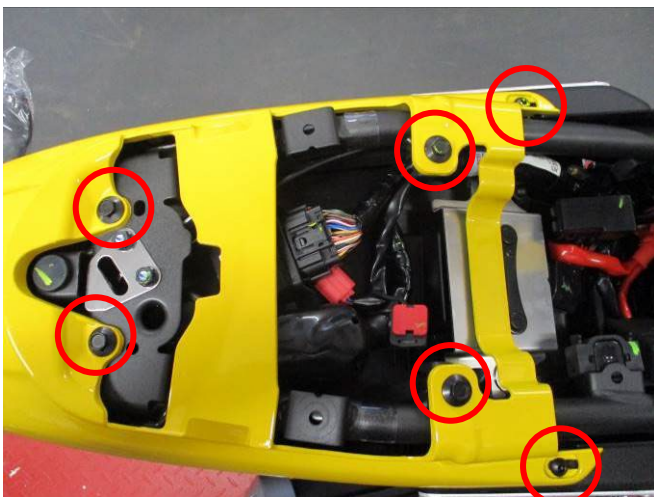

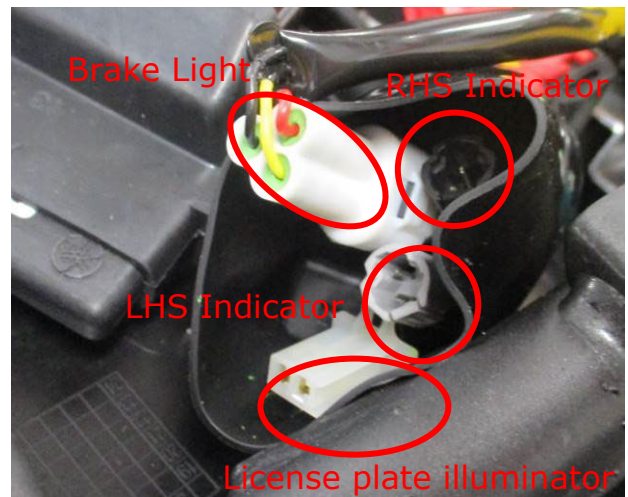
ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



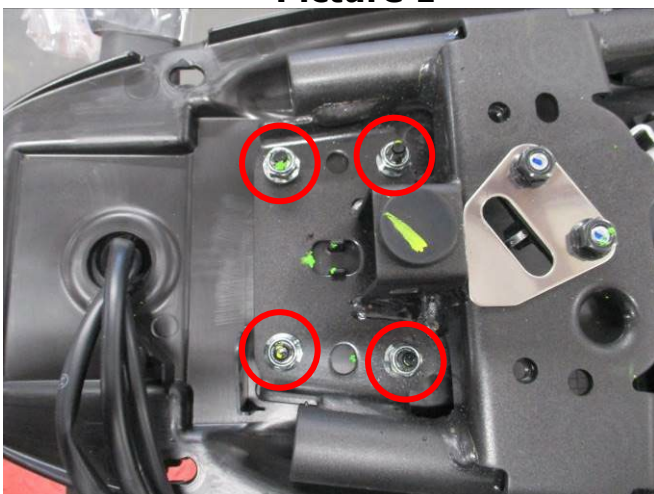

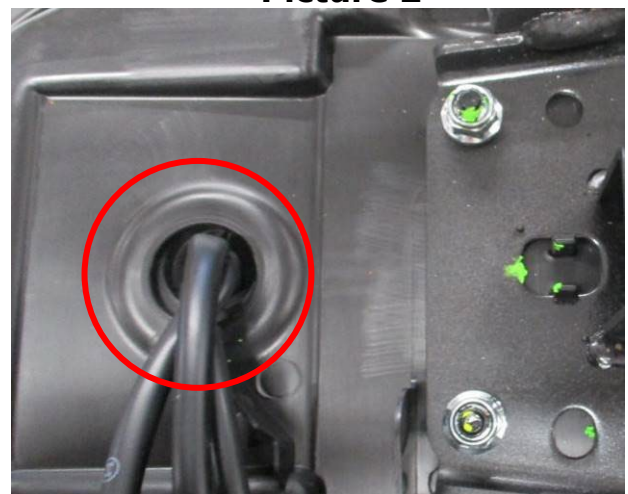

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Begin by removing the passenger seat using the key.
- Remove the bolts securing the top of the tail fairing to the bike as shown in **Picture 1** and also carefully whilst holding the tail fairing to stop it from falling, remove the 4 x black screws from the underside of the tail to separate and remove the fairing from the bike.
- Now, with the tail ready to be lifted away, disconnect the 4 connectors highlighted in **Picture 2**.
- Remove the 4 x locking nuts as shown in **Picture 3** and carefully remove the OEM license plate bracket from the bike.
- Keep the 4 x OEM spacers safely to one side which are used to mount the OEM license plate bracket to the bike.
- Referring to the **ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM** above, pre-assemble the R&G Tail Tidy (**ITEM 1**) by attaching your OEM indicators to the bike along with the provided license plate illuminator (**ITEM 2**) and also the rubber bung to protect cables (**ITEM 8**).
- Thread the indicator cables along with the LA0002 cable through the rubber lined hole in the R&G Tail Tidy as shown in **Picture 4**.
- Protect the LA0002 wires by using the provided heat shrink (**ITEM 6**).
- Attach the provided license plate illuminator connector (**ITEM 3**).
- Tidy up all cables using the provided cable ties (**ITEM 7**) and slotted holes provided in the license plate bracket.
- Secure the R&G Tail Tidy to the bike using the bolts and washers provided (**ITEMS 4 & 5**) as shown in **ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM**, re-use the OEM spacers and locking nuts to attach to the bike.
- Check that the indicators and license plate illuminator are wired correctly and operating as they should before re-installing the tail fairing and seat.

IMPORTANT: IF FITTING A FULL-SIZE LICENCE PLATE AND PLACING IT FAR DOWN ON THE LICENCE PLATE HANGER, THERE IS A SMALL CHANCE OF THE LICENCE PLATE HITTING THE BACK WHEEL UNDER HEAVY LOAD AND OVER LARGE BUMPS IN THE ROAD. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK FOR THIS POSSIBILITY AND TAKE AVOIDING ACTION. FAILURE TO CHECK THIS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.
